No.	Frequently Asked Questions	Answers
1	In 2025-II the version change will be made in plan D, from which cycle will this variation be made in the SUBE program?	The change in the Sube Program will be implemented from the eighth cycle onwards.
2	I've already completed all the subjects from the first and second cycles, but my current curriculum shows pending courses from those cycles. What does that mean?	This is due to a reorganization of the curriculum. You can verify this information by visiting: My subjects >> Curriculum
3	From what academic period will English classes be taught in person?	English classes will be taught in person starting from the 2025-2 academic period.
4	When will the Marketing Fundamentals course be offered?	The Fundamentals of Marketing curriculum experience was incorporated from the 2025-2 academic period, within Curriculum Plan E.
5	Will the mesh change from version EV01 to EV02 also apply to the blended learning modality?	Yes. The change from version EV01 to EV02 applies to all study modalities, including blended learning.
6	Is it possible for students to complete curricular experiences in advance during the summer term?	No, it is not possible to advance curricular experiences in the summer cycle.
7	If I'm in mesh C or D, how many credits can I normally carry?	Students in grid C or D can enroll in up to a maximum of 22 credits per academic period.
8	If I am in grid E, how many credits am I entitled to?	In the E grid you can enroll in up to 23 regular credits per academic period.
9	If I am in curriculum E, can I enroll in more than 23 credits?	The student may increase their credits if they have not failed any curricular experience in the previous semester and have an average greater than or equal to 14.
10	What percentage of classes in curriculum E will be virtual, and how will they be distributed?	In grid E, the percentage of virtuality increased to 30%, which means that the student will take 1 course in virtual mode for each academic cycle.



11	Will the Health Sciences degrees also change their format this year?	No. The Health Sciences programs will not change version during the 2025-2 academic period; this change will only be implemented starting from the following 2026-1 period.
12	What is the difference between the EV01 and EV02 mesh?	The main difference lies in the organization of the curricular experiences. In the EV01 curriculum, the general curricular experiences are concentrated in the first semesters; while in the EV02 curriculum these are distributed throughout different cycles.
13	In the 2025-II semester, what plan will the first-cycle students enter with?	Students in the first cycle will enter with Plan E Version 2.
14	As of August 18, which campus is currently transferring in-person enrollments?	Currently, the Ate Campus is the only one carrying out the process of transferring in-person enrollments.
15	Since which semester have these changes been applied to the registration process?	These changes will be implemented starting in semester 2025–2, which is the first academic period in which they will come into effect.
16	In which schools are the version changes being implemented?	The changes are being implemented in all schools, without exception.
17	Will the new change delay students' progress in their curricular experiences?	No. If there has been a change in the name of the course, it has an equivalent in the new curriculum. This process is automatic and will not cause any delays in the student's academic progress.
18	What changes were applied to mesh D with the new versions?	The main change was that some courses moved to the virtual modality, in compliance with the SUNEDU provision, which establishes that in the face-to-face modality up to 30% can be virtual.
